

Terms and Conditions for the return of Term 4 make up lessons for Term 3 Learn-to-Swim 2020

All Learn-to-Swim parents/carers need to read and understand The Geelong College COVID- 19 management plan for Learn-to-Swim members These resources explain the safety measures in place and your responsibilities while in the Centre.

Class numbers

A minimum of three enrolments is required to confirm a class. The maximum will be six depending on the swimming ability of the class. If your class has less than three students the Learn-to-Swim Coordinator will contact you to arrange an alternative day, class and time. Please note that some levels may be combined to accommodate these changes.

Instructions for classes

Sessions will be coordinated and controlled by the Learn-to-Swim Coordinator each day. Please follow instructions so sessions run on time. During this period session times may be affected slightly however every effort will be made to ensure things run smoothly; we ask for your help and understanding with this.

Please help us by:

- **Following all directions from staff**
- **Showering before and after at home**
- **Hand sanitising upon entering the Centre**
- **Adhering to all procedures**
- **Being organised and on time**
- **Being ready to swim**
- **Paying term fees prior to term (Via phoning the centre)**
- **Staying in your designated area**
- **Wearing a mask while at the Centre unless you are under 12 years or are swimming**

Parking

Please plan ahead as parking may be difficult during Learn-to-Swim times.

If you're sick, stay at home: If you have any of the following symptoms of COVID-19 you must not attend the Recreation Centre: cough, sore throat, runny nose, sneezing, loss of taste or sense of smell, elevated temperature, shortness of breath, unusual fatigue, unusual muscle aches and pains, or diarrhoea. Signage at the entry to the Centre will remind patrons of this.

You can have COVID-19 but show no signs of ill health or fever. We ask that patrons **do not attend** the Recreation Centre if they have travelled internationally, feel unwell, or had contact with someone diagnosed with the virus. If we suspect that any patron is unwell, we reserve the right to ask them to leave the premises for the safety of other customers and staff.

Temperature Testing: All staff and patrons will have their temperature checked on arrival at the Centre. If you or your child have a fever, you won't be permitted inside the venue.

Managing Social Distance Requirements: Social distancing requirements will be enforced. Signage and markers have been placed throughout high traffic areas of the Centre and designated spectator seating areas, to guide patrons. Staff will monitor and actively enforce that families remain seated in their designated areas. There will be no swimming before and after lessons.

Minimise time at the venues: Swimmers and patrons must follow the guideline of 'get in, swim, get out', arriving at sessions ready for activities. Changerooms and toilets will be available, however **showers will not** be available to patrons. All personal items and swimming gear are to be placed in your designated area and not left in the changerooms.

Spectator Management: Spectators/parents in the facility must comply with physical distancing. Swimmers will be restricted to having one parent or carer only in the venue. While it is preferable not to bring non-swimming siblings, we understand that in some situations this is not possible. If you have a child with you it is your responsibility to ensure they abide by social distancing and safety measures.

Sign In: All parents/carers will need to sign in on arrival. You are encouraged to bring your own pen, but there will be spare pens and hand sanitiser provided.

Absentees: If your child is sick please inform the Centre that they are not attending their lesson, where possible with 24 hours' notice. If your child is sick and has a Doctors' certificate they will only be credited for that lesson if 24 hours' notice has been given. This enables their position to be used if need be.

COVID Absentees: If your family has had potential exposure to a COVID-19 case, you must not attend your lesson. Follow the directions from the DHHS and get tested if you show signs or symptoms. You must inform the Centre and the Centre



will endeavour to provide a makeup class where possible. These makeup classes cannot be carried over into a new term. The holiday intensive program will be considered for makeup classes where available. You may be requested to provide the Centre evidence of your test, test result or other documentation to support this request.

Hygiene and cleanliness: The pool water is continuously being disinfected with chlorine. Therefore, the main areas of concern will be areas out of the water where people are standing or sitting. There are hand sanitising stations at the entry and exit points, and in the hallway to the changerooms. Please make use of these. The Centre will have increased scheduled cleaning e.g. hourly spray disinfection of high touch points such as door handles, seating areas and equipment. Major cleaning by staff will occur out of hours and will involve anti-viral disinfectant of all major surfaces.

Staff Training: All staff have completed The Geelong College COVID-19 return to work course and have been inducted into the Centre by Management.

Reporting Procedures: If there is a case of COVID-19 reported at our premises we will be following all directives from the State Health Authority and complying with all cleaning and disinfecting procedures. We encourage all patrons to download the COVIDsafe app.

Equipment safety: No goggles, swim caps, bathers and towels are available for loan. All toys will be removed from the pool area and the activity table will not be available. Equipment used in swimming lessons will be kept to a minimum but if it is used it will be sanitised after each use.

Payments: The majority of Learn-to-Swim members have credits from Term 3 that will pay for the Term 4 classes starting on the 29th October 2020. Students that have been allocated a position in the Term 4 program who do not have credit will need to arrange payment over the phone by calling the office on 52263 129.

Merchandise and drinks can still be purchased from reception. Card payments are preferred.
